

"A Dedicated Determined Dependable Disciple" Part III - "A Dependable Disciple" Matthew 6:21; Luke 9:57-62 By Melvin J. Bryant II

Last week we embarked on the second installment of this series called, "A Determined Disciple"!

This week we will discuss the LAST installment of this lesson, "A Dependable Disciple"!

I. WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO BE DEPENDABLE?

- A. Merriam Webster defines it as someone who is, "Capable of being trusted or depended on : (a person who is ;-) RELIABLE."
- B. A "Dependable" person is someone who is reliable and trustworthy or who can be counted on.
- C. It is equivalent to being, "Faithful"! (see 1 Corinthians 4:1-2).
 - There are THREE things in these verses that we must take into consideration!
 - (1) As Christians, we are "SERVANTS of Christ"!
 - As a "Servant" we are those who, "....function as a helper in a subordinate capacity, an assistant." (BDAG pg. 1035).
 - (2) As Christians, we are, "STEWARDS"!
 - A "Steward" is someone who is a manager of a household or an estate." (BDAG pg. 698).
 - **Husbands** are "Stewards"! (1 Timothy 3:1-7 emphasis on verse 4)!
 - We need to know how to RULE OUR OWN HOUSE WELL!
 - That means the WIFE needs to understand her role! She is not to exercise "Authority" over the man! (1 Timothy 2:11-12)! This applies in the "church house" AND the "home"!
 - **Children** needs to be in Submission (that means they need to, "obey the directives of the one who's in charge") with ALL Reverence (*that is*, "with all Respect")!
 - God has ALWAYS commanded men to be the HEAD'S of their own home! (see Genesis 18:19)!
 - And, as a point of reference: Isaac was not a little boy!
 - How do we know this? (1). Genesis 21:34, after Isaac was born, the Bible tells us that, "Abraham stayed in the land of the Philistines MANY days!" Some time has elapsed and Isaac grew older. (2). Abraham was old, and in Genesis 22:6 we are told, "So Abraham took the wood of the burnt offering and laid it on Isaac his son; and he took the fire in his hand, and a knife, and the two of them went together." Isaac was OLD enough (and strong enough) to carry the wood of the burnt offering up the mountain! (3). God KNEW that Abraham would command his children and his household after him, that they keep the Way of the Lord.... (see Genesis 22:7)! Isaac was OLD ENOUGH to Understood that when they worshiped God in the past, they needed "Fire" and "Wood" but Isaac KNEW that a LAMB was needed as well! He learned this from his father Abraham!
 - Abraham servant was obedient to God (Genesis 24:1ff).
 - Joshua was Faithful (Dependable) in all his house (Joshua 24:15).
 - Can we KNOW that God can DEPEND on us to be the "Stewards" that He has commissioned for us to be?!
 - (3) As Christians, it is REQUIRED that we be found "FAITHFUL"!

• "Faithful" Greek word: "Pistos," which means, "Reliable or; Dependable"! (BDAG pg. 820).

II. ALL DISCIPLES ARE TO BE DEPENDABLE STEWARDS (see 1 Peter 4:10).

- A. Dependability is a must for the Christian in all areas of life!
 - Dependability (or Faithfulness) is Required in our Worship, how we care for our families, in our marriages, in how we treat one another, etc.!
 - Every child of God is a "Steward" and each one of us have a Gift (and some of us have more that one Gift) that we are to minister to one another!
 - NOT to be confused to what these "Gifts" are!
 - We find the Diversities of "Gifts" in 1 Corinthians 12:4-11!
 - We find in 1 Corinthians 12:7-11, 9 miraculous gifts the early church had and NONE of them are being exercised today!

For instance:

- NO ONE has the Miraculous "Gifts of Healings" today because the person claiming to have this "Gift" would have no problem healing any and everyone from Covid-19 (and we don't see them offering their assistance do we?)!
- NO ONE has the Miraculous "Gift" of speaking in "Different Kinds of Tongues" today because "Tongue" speaking (according to Acts 2:5-12) was another LANGUAGE (emphasis on verse 7)!
- So, ALL the Miraculous "Gifts" here, "to know all things without learning," "to discern spirits," "to interpret tongues" were "Gifts" each ONE in the early church had, and those "Gifts" were not to be used for personal benefit or personal gain! But God expected them to, "....minister it to one another, as good stewards of the manifold Grace of God."
- And, by the time we get to 1 Corinthians 13:8-9, we find a synecdoche, (*that is*, a part that represents the whole)! In 1 Corinthians 13:8-9, Paul (through the Spirit) does not mention all 9 gifts found in 1 Corinthians 12:4-11, there is no need to! The synecdoche in 1 Corinthians 13:8-9 confirms that ALL the gifts will fail, cease or vanish away ONCE (1 Corinthians 13:10), "....that which is PERFECT has come, then that which is in part will be done away."
- The Miraculous ability of "Gifts" were done away once the completed written word was delivered! (James 1:25)!

III. AN UNDEPENDABLE SERVANT (see Matthew 25:14-30).

- A. Each and every Christian is Required to be Faithful to what God has entrusted you with!
 - And, God is NOT requiring you to do no more than what you are capable of doing (verse 15)! But; you must be doing something!
 - From a Generic sense, each and every Christian has a "Talent"!
 - Whether you're like Joses, an encourager, (Acts 4:36)! A Giver and Generous, like Tabitha in Acts 9:39, Each and EVERYONE of us have a TALENT and it can be used for the benefit and profit of ALL (cf. Romans 12:6-8).
 - The first man was given 5 talents and gained 5 more! The second man was given 2 talents and gained two more and BOTH of these servants were told, "Well done, good and faithful (Or; Dependable, Trustworthy) servant; you were faithful over a few things, I will make you ruler over many things. Enter into the joy of your lord." (verses 21 and 23). But the man who received ONE talent didn't make any effort and the Lord called him a WICKED and LAZY servant!
 - Here is the main thrust of the parable....Be FAITHFUL in using the opportunities that God has given to us! Regardless of what we have, we are only STEWARDS of what God has given to us (Matthew 25:14)! ALL the "Goods" whether Monetary, Our Family, The word of God, ANY AND EVERYTHING belongs to God, we are just "Stewards" of the Goods that God has put into our possession, and we are REQUIRED to be Faithful and Dependable Disciples with what He has entrusted to us!
 - Be encouraged brethren, until the LAST AMEN......
