

# "Worship...God" Part III John 4:23-24 By Melvin J. Bryant II

Worship has been something that God requires mankind to do from the beginning of time. He has ALWAYS required man to worship Him. Now under different administration, *that is*, dispensational periods, And when I say, "Dispensational Periods," I am simply referring to a system of order of HOW God desired to be "Worship".

## I. WHAT IS WORSHIP?

- A. <u>BDAG</u> defines "Worship" as, "to express in attitude or gesture one's complete dependence on or submission to a high authority figure, (to fall down and) worship, do obeisance to, prostrate oneself before, do reverence to, welcome respectfully." (3rd ed., p. 882).
- B. <u>Liddell and Scott</u> defines "Worship" as, "to make obeisance to gods, fall down and worship, to adore."
- C. <u>Louw-Nida</u> defines "Worship" as, "to prostrate oneself before someone as an act of reverence, fear, or supplication—'to prostrate oneself before." (Vol. 1, p. 217)

#### II. THERE ARE THREE SYSTEMS OF ORDER WE FIND IN THE BIBLE

- (1) There was the "Patriarchal Period."
  - How did they "Worship" God under this period of time? (see Genesis 4:1-5).
    - (a) Adam and Eve had two sons, and even with these sons, God required them to offer Him proper (or true) worship!
      - Both sons were required to bring their offerings!
      - Cain brought an offering of the "Fruit of the Ground." (verse 3).
      - Abel also brought of the "Firstborn of his flock and of their fat." (verse 4).
      - *However*, God did NOT Respect Cain and his offering. (verse 5). And, God NOT respecting his offering, Cain was very angry, and his countenance fell.
      - The reason why God had NO RESPECT for Cain's offering is because he offered it without adhering to the commands of the Lord!
      - There are "some" in religious circles who TRY to offer an explanation and say that God didn't Respect Cain's offering because it was not from the First Fruit. That's inaccurate. (cf. Romans 10:17; Hebrews 11:4). Abel's offering was a "More Excellent Sacrifice" than Cain because Abel emphatically offered his gift BY FAITH, that is, by OBEYING what God commanded!
      - We can't offer to God what we cannot find WRITTEN in the Word of God!
    - (b) God tries to help Cain and put him on the right path (Genesis 4:6-7).
      - What is God telling us here? If we want to be well pleasing to Him, ("If" we want to do well;-) we MUST do what He commands! And, "IF" we do what He commands under the dispensational period of worship that governs us, we WILL be accepted by Him just as Abel was accepted!
      - Allow me to add this....God didn't have to tell Cain not to offer the fruit, ONCE He established what He desired, EVERYTHING ELSE was Unauthorized!
      - We CANNOT offer God what He has NOT Commanded!

- (2) There was the "Mosaic Period."
  - (a) Under the "Mosaic Administration," God commanded Israel to Worship Him a certain way! (see Exodus 30:8; Leviticus 9:22-24).
    - God has ALWAYS given instructions as to how we wants His command(s) carried out!
    - In Exodus chapter 29, Aaron and his sons are consecrated for the service of the Lord, (they are Priest Today, we are a "Royal Priesthood" according to 1 Peter 2:9, and; WE are to carry out the commands under Christ Administration JUST as God has commanded.
    - In Exodus 30:8-9, God is telling Aaron and his sons what He EXPECTS of THEM when burning incense on the alter. So, God has ESTABLISHED what He Expects!
    - Under the "Mosaic Administration," there were several offering made. Leviticus 9:4 speaks of, the Sin Offering, the Burnt Offering, the Peace Offering, And; the Grain Offering and these "Offerings" had to be ACCORDING to the PRESCRIBED MANNER! (Leviticus 9:16).
    - What is the point here? God is SPECIFIC on how He desires things to be done!
    - Once Moses and Aaron did EXACTLY what God commanded, how did He respond to their offering? (see Leviticus 9:22-24).
    - There was a "Prescribed Manner" on how God desired things to be done, under the "Patriarchal System," that is, with Adam, Cain and Abel, Noah, Abraham and others! AND; under the "Mosaic System" there was a "Prescribed Manner" of how God desired things to be done with the children of Israel....Anything else outside of what is commanded is UNAUTHORIZED!
  - (b) The Profane fire of Nadab and Abihu (Leviticus 10:1-2)
    - God had already established in Exodus 30:9 that He commanded the Priest NOT to offer ANY Strange (or Profane) fire on the alter!
    - Here is a CLEAR example of what we call, doing things our way in worship!
    - Now, here are some clear pointers that we sometimes miss when studying this: (1). Each son had to come before the Lord with their offering (just like Cain and Abel). *In other words*, today, I can't WORSHIP for you, And, you can't Worship for me! As Christians, EACH ONE OF US are to come before the Lord with the appropriate sacrifices today! (2). Each son was accountable for their own actions! God is NOT going to hold me responsible for your LACK of service to Him, and He will NOT hold you accountable for my lack of service to Him! (3). Each son had his censer that had to be offered! If you want to come before the Lord today and mumble SING to Him, that's on you, BUT; I plan to lift my VOICE to God in Psalms, Hymns and Spiritual Songs, IUST AS HE HAS COMMANDED!
    - We are NOT to ALTER (Or Substitute) what God has Commanded! We are NOT to give God LESS than what He has Commanded! We are NOT to GO BEYOND what is Written! (1 Corinthians 4:6). Deuteronomy 12:32, God said, "WHATEVER I COMMAND you, be CAREFUL to Observe it; you shall NOT ADD to NOR take away from it!" (cf. Deuteronomy 4:2; 13:18; Proverbs 30:6 Revelation 22:18-19).
- (3) There is the Christian Dispensation. (John 4:23-24).
  - Today, we "Worship" God in "Spirit," that is, in sincerity (with the right heart), And; "Truth" is according to the Word of God. (John 17:17).
  - How are we commanded to "Worship" God today? We Offer prayers to God through Christ Jesus (Colossians 3:17). We Observed the Lord's supper (Acts 20:7). We GIVE of our means (1 Corinthians 16:2). Preachers are to TEACH and PREACH the Word of God (Acts 20:7). We are to COLLECTIVELY sing songs....that is, EVERYONE is required to sing SPIRITUAL song to God in service to Him. (Colossians 3:16). And, ALL these, "Acts of Worship" are to be conducted on THE FIRST DAY OF THE WEEK! "IF" we miss ANY ONE of these, our "Worship" service is INCOMPLETE, and therefore, GOD will NOT accept it! To be continued....
