

"The Prophetic Prophet and the Prince of Peace" Isaiah 9:6 By Melvin J. Bryant II

It is no surprise to us as Christians that Jesus is the Savior of the World. That He is the Prophetic Prophet that Moses spoke about in Deuteronomy 18:15, And He is the Prince of Peace found in Isaiah 9:6! However, during this time of year, MANY people come (and go) to worship to show their respect to the Savior of the World! They put their Sunday's BEST on, and they come to show homage to the Savior of the World! *However*, sadly, next week, the same ones you may see in worship today, will be ABSENT until next year during this time! And as most of us ought to know, there is NO scripture that authorizes Christians to celebrate Easter And put this ONE DAY of the year on a pedestal and disregard all other First Day's of the Week! This week comes around ONCE a year and men have been conditioned to celebrate it only during this time of year! We are to be MINDFUL of Colossians 3:17 and 1 Peter 4:11! Nonetheless, some will argue that the word "Easter" is in the Bible (Acts 12:4), however, it simply means, "Passover" And it has NO ASSOCIATION with a Bunny Rabbit or Hunting for Colorful Eggs or ANY other thing of the sort! So, just because we come across "some" words in the Bible that maybe hard to explain, it does not mean that we invoke our definition on that word when the CONTEXT will explain the word to us! *Nonetheless...* I do understand that many people's minds are on Resurrection of Jesus Christ this morning and that's GREAT! The Resurrection of Jesus Christ IS a Biblical Subject found in Luke 24:1-6! Jesus DID Rise from the Grave on the First Day of the Week! And the Word "Resurrection" simply means, "Rising Up." (BDAG pg. 71). So, Jesus did RISE UP from the Grave! Peter said in Acts 2:24, "whom God raised up...." Romans 6:4 tells us, "....that just as Christ was RAISED from the dead BY the GLORY of the Father...." Galatians 6:1 tells us, "Paul an apostle (not from men nor through men, but through Jesus Christ and God the Father who RAISED Him (Jesus) from the dead)!" We are THANKFUL for the "Resurrection" of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ! But....What does the Bible command of us to do on Sunday's, the First Day of the Week?

- We are COMMANDED in Hebrews 10:25 to assemble with the Saints, EVERY first day of the week (cf. Acts 20:7)!
- We are COMMANDED in 1 Corinthians 11:23ff (in that assembly) to remember the Death, the Burial and the Resurrection of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ EVERY First Day of the Week -NOT JUST ON "EASTER" Sunday! This is why we partake of the Lord's supper EVERY First Day of the Week!
- We are COMMANDED to Worship God in Spirit and in Truth (John 4:24), and that is EVERY First Day of the Week (Acts 20:7)! We REMEMBER the Sacrifice of the Lord Jesus Christ EVERY First Day of the Week (as commanded) and we partake of the Lord's supper Every First Day of the Week! (1 Corinthians 10:16 cf. Acts 20:7).

I. WHO IS JESUS?

- A. One sure thing we need to recognize is that Jesus is God! (Matthew 1:23; Hebrews 1:9).
 - However, He is NOT God the Father, NOR is He God the Spirit, But; He IS God the Son!
 - And Jesus was prophesied about from the beginning of time! (cf. Genesis 3:15).
 - But, I want to go a step further....
- B. Jesus had GLORY before the World began. (see John 17:5).
 - Jesus had GLORY with His Father, BEFORE the World even began, which tells us that Jesus existed BEFORE the World was ever created! (cf. John 1:1-2).
 - There are religious groups professing that Jesus was created....NOT so according to Isaiah 43:10!

- C. He came in the form of a Bondservant (Philippians 2:5).
 - A "Bondservant", "pertains to a state of being completely controlled by someone or something....Subservient to, controlled by." (Louw & Nida vol. 1 pg. 471).
 - Jesus HUMBLED Himself and came in the form of a Bondservant! He removed His High rank of Glory, all the privileges that was associated with His Glory, He didn't come here as a Rich King, He didn't come here with the Power of Men, He made Himself of NO Reputation! (v.7).
 - Since Jesus accomplished His Father's will, every knee should bow for God has exalted His name above EVERY name (vs 9-11). This is why Jesus could say in Matthew 28:18, "ALL Authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth.
- D. He became POOR so that you and I can become RICH (see 2 Corinthians 8:9).
 - Now, Jesus didn't become POOR so that we can become Physically Rich with this world's Goods!
 - Jesus didn't come Preaching a Prosperity Gospel~!
 - What is a Prosperity Gospel? Jesus didn't come saying "IF" you put so much in the collection tray, you will receive 10 fold in return....BUT we hear it in "Prosperity Preaching!
 - If you're in Christ Jesus, you MIGHT be POOR Financially, BUT you are RICH with Him Spiritually....the TRUE riches is in our obedience to the Will of God! (cf. Colossians 3:2)!
 - Remember the church in Smyrna, the Lord said that He knew their works, Tribulation and POVERTY, but He said they were RICH (Revelation 2:9). The church didn't allow the Tribulation and the Poverty to STOP them from serving God, they remained TRUE to Him despite their tribulations, despite their Poverty!
 - Jesus tells us that we WILL have Tribulation in the world but we are to be of Good Cheer for He has overcome the world (John 16:33).

II. JESUS WENT TO THE CROSS OF CALVARY

- A. He came as the "Prince of Peace" (Isaiah 9:6).
 - But He also came with the Sword (Matthew 10:34-36).
 - What is the Lord saying here? A man, will choose to take up His cross....There will be DAILY burdens and struggles! The man separates himself from the religious systemic system of his father or his fathers sinful ways! The man follows Jesus (John 10:27). And when he makes that decision, the SWORD has been used because it SEPARATE, (it Sets a Man) against His father because the man choses to follow God rather than his father!
- B. His sentencing, scourging and death was unjustified!
 - They falsely accused Him and He was innocent! The slapped the Lord the First time when He stood before the High Priest (John 18:19-22). Pilate found NO FAULT in Him but still scourged Him and delivered Him to be crucified! (Matthew 27:26).
 - They rather for the Rebel, Robber and Murderer Barabbas to be released rather than Jesus!
 - But we thank God for sending Jesus because....

III. THERE IS POWER IN THE BLOOD

- A. Our sins are REMITTED by His Blood (Matthew 26:28; 1 Peter 2:24)
- B. Our sins are FORGIVEN because of His Blood (Isaiah 1:18)
- C. We are JUSTIFIED by His Blood (Romans 5:9)
- D. We are SANCTIFIED by His Blood (Hebrews 13:12)
- E. We are REDEEMED by His Blood (1 Peter 1:17-21; Titus 2:14)
- F. We are brought NEAR by His Blood (Ephesians 2:13)! Be encouraged brethren by the death of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, for without His sacrifice, we are nothing!
