"The EXCUSES That We Make"

Luke 14:16-24

Many of us are guilty of making excuses at one time or another! I KNOW I'm guilty of making excuses if I didn't complete a particular task, I find myself making an excuse for why I didn't do it! We find ourselves making excuses for many things in our lives! We've ALL heard the story of the little boy who didn't turn in his homework assignment! The teacher asked, "*Johnny, where is your homework?*" and the first thing that came out of Johnny's mouth was, "*The dog ate it!*"! Even when we are to be doing the Lord's will....Reading (1 Timothy 4:13), Studying (2 Timothy 2:15), Evangelizing (Matthew 28:18-20), MANY of us will make "Excuses" for NOT doing what the Lord instructs! Jesus said in Luke 6:46, "But why do you call Me 'Lord, Lord,' and not do the things which I say?"

I. EXCUSES DEFINED

- A. Excuses comes from a "Greek word" that means, "To try to serve or to justify"!
 - The word originally meant, "to give a defense or reason for something."
- B. Strong's Greek Dictionary Defines Excuses as, "to beg off, i.e to deprecate, decline, to shun, Avoid....refuse, reject!"
- C. Louw & Nida defied "Excuses" as, "to ask for with urgency, even to the point of demanding —'to ask for, to demand, to plead for.'" (electronic ed. of the 2nd edition., Vol. 1, p. 406)."

II. JESUS GAVE A PARABLE TO COMBAT EXCUSE MAKING

- A. Excuse making is nothing new (Ecclesiastes 1:9), and has been around since the beginning of time!
 - Remember Adam? Eve? (Genesis 3:12-13)!
- B. A Certain Man gave a Great Supper and invited MANY! (Luke 14:16-17)!
 - The Man here in the parable is symbolic of God!
 - The Great Supper is symbolic of God's earthly kingdom...And;
 - "The Many" will be the Israelites or today, ANYONE in the world that's invited!
- C. ALL things are ready
 - The fullness of time has come, ALL things are ready is likely symbolizing the time AFTER the Lord resurrection!
 - God has extended His invitation to MANY, to EVERYONE!
 - Romans 1:6 tells us, "For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the POWER of God to salvation for EVERYONE who believes, for the JEW FIRST and ALSO for the GREEK!" Now notice...
- D. The "Excuse" of the FIRST Man (Luke 14:18)!
 - "I have bought a piece of ground, and I must go and see it. I ask you to have me excused."
 - It is highly unusual for one to buy land without First SEEING it!
 - Even "IF" he bought the land without seeing it first, WHY the urgency to see it NOW after being invited to the Great Supper!
 - Why NOT first go to the feast then AFTERWARDS go see about your land?

Application:

- Many will NOT come to worship because they are preoccupied with the things of this world!
- I'm too busy trying to find my dream house or trying to find a house! I'm too busy trying to Sell my house! And we KNOW there are more insane EXCUSES! If men would just READ their Bibles and understand what Psalms 50:10-12 tells us! ALL things belong to God...You House, Your Car, Your Land, EVEN Your own LIFE, so WHY would ANYONE put ANYTHING before the Lord!

- So, the FIRST man made an “excuse” not to come to the Great Supper on “Property” that he does NOT really own, BUT; just borrowing from the Lord ANYWAY!
- E. The “EXCUSE” of the Second Man (Luke 14:19)!
- "I have bought five yoke of oxen, and I am going to test them. I ask you to have me excused."
 - This too is a “weak excuse” NOT to come to the “Great Supper”!
 - Could he NOT test them AFTERWARDS? Could he NOT have “tested” them on another day? Why is it so urgent to test them once you’ve been invited?

Application

- How many times do we find ourselves making “excuses” to “excuse” ourselves from the Lord’s invitation (from church) because of work or some business we have to run?
- How many times have we heard of people saying, “I can’t come today because I have to work.”
- Now here is the questions we need to ask ourselves....Who blessed you with the Job? Who gave you your life health and strength? Who gave you the means to buy those five yoke of oxen or the food you put on your table? GOD did....And Since God gave you these things, WHY make Excuses NOT to serve Him?!
- Even the founder of Chick Fil A (who, mind you) is NOT and was NOT a Christian closed his business doors on the first day of the week!
- Now allow me to give you all some added incentives the Lord has in place that MANY of you may not be aware of...
- Federal Law, Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 letter (J), protects individuals from discrimination, based on religion unless an employer demonstrates that he is unable to reasonably accommodate to an employee’s or prospective employee’s religious observance or practice without undue hardship on the conduct of the employer’s business and with so many companies today, this is unlikely!

F. The Third Man “Excuse”! (Luke 14:20)!

- “I have married a wife, and therefore I cannot come.”
- Another PITIFUL “Excuse!”
- The invitation was (and is) given to ALL, why NOT bring your wife to the “Great Supper”? Why NOT bring your “Wife” to worship?

Application:

- How many of us have used the Family as an “excuse” (or we KNOW of members who use family as an excuse) NOT to come to worship?
- How many of us have used the “excuse” of a family member coming from out of state as our “excuse” NOT to come to the “Lord’s house”?
- Why can’t we bring them to service with us and “IF” they have no desire to come, LEAVE THEM AT THE HOUSE!
- We should NOT allow ANYONE to stop us from serving and worshipping God!

III. KEEPING OURSELVES AT THE MASTERS FEET. (Luke 10:38-41).

- A. *Sometimes* we can get ourselves caught up like Martha and NOT realize where our TRUE focus should lie!
- Sometimes we can put the cares of this life before the commandments of the Lord and not realize that we are to be keeping ourselves at the Master’s feet by keeping His commandments!
 - Martha was WORRIED and TROUBLED about MANY THINGS and we need to realize what Jesus has said to us Matthew 6:25-34! I pray this lesson has served as a reminder of how we are to KEEP OURSELVES at the Feet of Our Lord by doing those things He has commanded and for us to keep ourselves committed to His will! Until the last Amen....
