"A Real Man will Lead a Godly House"

Joshua 24:15

We live in a day in which it is very difficult to be a godly man...A godly husband...A godly father! Today there is a GREAT shortage of REAL MEN in our world! We have those who call themselves MEN - But even their interior (what they fill their minds and body with...drugs, alcohol, and obscene things)... And exterior (the way some of these "So Called Men" dress with their pants hanging down) is nothing like what the Bible calls a MAN! Father's Day presents to us an opportunity to look at what it means to be a MAN, A Good Husband, a Good Father. There is NOTHING more important in this life than for a MAN to lead his family in the Lord! Money, Status, Prestige, Power or Possessions - Nothing is more important than for a man to lead his family in the Lord! And, the failure of a man who does not lead his family in the way God has desired has failed them and himself! *Nonetheless*, men have a Great responsibility, and it takes a Real Man to recognize his responsibility and to live and practice it!

I. WHAT IS A MAN?

- A. An adult male human. He is one who shows the QUALITIES (such as strength and courage) that men are TRADITIONALLY suppose to have! He is to be a person who CONTROLS or is in CHARGE or something! It is the quality or state of being MANLY! (Webster).
- B. What a man is not!
 - Just because you have children does not make you a Real Man!
 - Just because you are over the age of 18 or 21 does not make you a Real Man!
 - Just because you may have (or have had) many girlfriends... does not make you a Man!
 - Now, society may tell you that THAT makes you a man, BUT; God's word begs to differ!
- C. What makes a Real Man?
 - It is HE who submits himself to the will of God...
 - Allowing God to be the head over him...
 - Teaching our children to be virgins until marriage - that INCLUDES our sons!
 - Now those are "some" of the qualities that makes you a REAL MAN!!!!
 - Society does not want to hear this, BUT God commands that we teach this to our children!
 - Paul said something interesting about pleasing men over there in Galatians 1:10. "For do I now persuade men or God? Or do I seek to please men? For IF I still pleased men, I would NOT be a bondservant of Christ."
 - We did NOT become Christians to please men and to conform to what they consider GODLY or ACCEPTABLE!
 - YES fathers, let us teach our sons to play sports, fish, etc., *However*, let us teach them the importance of being a faithful Christian, a Faithful MAN of God!

II. WHAT ARE SOME RESPONSIBILITIES GOD HAS INSTRUCTED FOR THE MAN?

- A. Head of his wife! (Ephesians 5:23!)
 - That word "Head" comes from a Greek word, "*kephale*" which means, "One who is of supreme or pre-eminent status in view of authority to order or command! It is One who is the HEAD of, One who is SUPERIOR to, One who is SUPREME over..." (Louw-Nida vol. 1 pg. 738).
 - The MAN is the HEAD, the leader, the one who is in SUPREME control of the wife and of the ENTIRE household! (Joshua 24:15).
- B. Spiritual Leader of his children (Ephesians 6:4!)

- Fathers are not to “provoke their children to anger.” The Greek word translated “provoke” means “to rouse with anger or to enrage”!
- Now there are times when a son or daughter becomes sinfully angry because of their own immaturity; *However*, there are other times when we as fathers can “Provoke” our children to wrath.

For instance:

1. Some parents put too much “Pressure” on their children which would lead them to anger!
 - There was a story on HBO of these fathers who pushed their sons to breaking points TRYING to get them to be the next great football star or basketball phenom! Listen Fathers...you CANNOT live your life through the life of your child!
 - Let them make a decision as to what they want to grow up to be, and you encourage them and guide them on the right path! Also your child may not be as academically smart as you but we are to encourage them to do the BEST they can and not be lazy in their study habits!
2. Being too over protective of them!
 - We are to teach our children the way of the Lord and then TRUST they will do the right thing but; SOMETIMES children need to find out the hard way!
 - *Remember* the Prodigal son in Luke 15?
 - *Think about it...*The father taught his sons about God, raised them in a godly home, but for some Strange Reason, the younger son wanted to know what it was like to be in the world and so he went exploring! Did he know the dangers of it? Yes he did! How do we know? He was taught by his father!
 - When he went into the world, did he realize he was sinning? Yes he did! How do we know? He was taught by the father! Did he come to his senses? Yes he did when he realized that the world was not what he thought it would be!
 - Now, surely we would discourage our children from entering into the world of sin, but; the son had to learn for himself and the Bible tells us that he did “come to himself”. (Luke 15:17)!
 - Proverbs 22:6 remains true, “Train up a child in the way he should go, And when he is old he will not depart from it.”
- C. Spiritual Leadership begins in the home! (1 Timothy 3:4).
 - A few things to point out in 1 Timothy 3:4! (1) A man must know how to RULE his own house (And RULE it) WELL! That word “Rule” there comes from a Greek word that means, “*to exercise a position of LEADERSHIP, to rule, to direct, to be at the head! It means to put oneself at the head, to go first! It is to so influence others as to cause them to follow*” (Louw Nida vol1. pg. 464)! (2). He is to have his children in submission with all reverence! If the children exercise “foolishness,” the Bible tells us that the ROD OF CORRECTION will drive it far from him (Proverbs 22:15)!

III. REAL MEN WILL WALK IN THE WAY OF THE LORD (1 Kings 2:1-3)!

- A. According to what David has said, the ONLY way Solomon will be Strong and proving himself to be a MAN is by; (1) Keeping the charge of the Lord his God, (2) By walking in the Lord’s ways, And; (3) By keeping the Lord’s statutes, His commandments, His judgements and His testimonies as it was written in the law of Moses!
 - What can we LEARN from this Men? That the SAME holds true for men today, we are to “keep the commandments of the Lord our God!” Jesus said in John 14:15, “If you love Me, KEEP MY COMMANDMENTS!”
 - We are to Walk in the Lord’s ways! Ephesians 4:1 tells us, “I therefore, the prisoner of the Lord beseech you to WALK worthy of the calling with which you were called.”
- B. A Real Man will love his wife as Christ also loved the church (Ephesians 5:25).
 - Husbands lead first by showing sacrificial love to their wives, to make her feel secure and happy. Doing this will make it easier for her to submit to your guidance. Be encouraged!
